The boards:

EIT Culture & Creativity (EIT CC) is looking for professionals of the culture and creativity sectors and industries (CCSI) to play an important role in maintaining excellence in the EIT CC organisation and act as key advisors to support the proper implementation of processes and the management on intellectual property rights related issues.

The two boards are of high strategic importance for EIT CC and require professionals with a high level of ethics:

- The **Ethical, Legal and Social Issues (ELSI) Board** will play a key role in advising the implementation of key processes respecting the highest level of compliance with compliant with ethical, legal and social principles;
- The **Intellectual Property (IP) Board** will play a key role in providing key insights on the IP strategy and its operationalisation.

Contribution:

EIT CC is looking for professionals that will offer their support in kind to participate in online meetings twice a year for a duration of 2 hours as well as 2 online bilateral advisory activities for 1 hour per year.

For any work beyond the above, compensation is offered on the basis of 550 Euros per day for eligible costs under the EIT grant agreement. A compensation guide will be published in due time.

Profile:

Professional advisors are requested to demonstrate at least 5 years of relevant professional experience. In addition, professionals must have in-depth knowledge of the creative and cultural sectors.



**Next steps:**

The first bilateral meeting of one hour is expected to take place on the 29th January 2025.

Application:

EIT CC will designate an evaluation committee to review the applications received, the applications will be reviewed and score by at least 2 members of the management team. The evaluation will be made based on the relevance of the profile as well as the excellence of the professional background.
